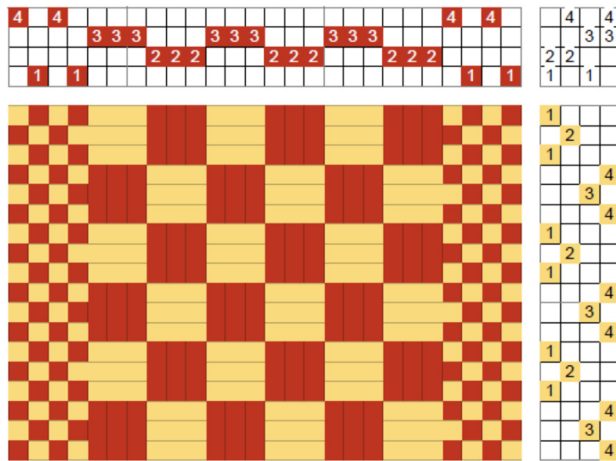


# Basket Weave, Canvas Weave and Huck Lace Comparison

To make the comparison more obvious, here the threading for basket weave (see entry) uses



shafts 2 and 3 for the basket and shafts 1 and 4 for length-wise plain weave; 3-thread blocks are used (see drawdown on the left); the huck lace is threaded in the traditional 4-shaft version (see entry for version to extend to more shafts); 5-thread blocks are used (see drawdown below right). The drawdown for the canvas weave (see entry) is on the left below.

<b>Plain Weave</b>	Only length-wise	Not possible	Length & width-wise
<b>Size of block</b>	Variable, odd or even	Generally 4 threads	Variable, odd, generally 5-threads
<b>Floats</b>	Floats over all threads in block, when one block weaves warp floats, the other weaves weft floats	Floats over all threads in block, when one block weaves warp floats, the other weaves weft floats	Floats over all threads in block, when one block weaves warp floats, the other weaves weft floats
<b>Tie-up</b>	On opposites: 1 & 3; 2 & 4; 1 & 2; 3 & 4	On opposites: 1 & 3; 2 & 4; 1 & 2; 3 & 4	On opposites: 1 & 3; 2 & 4; 1 & 2; 3 & 4
