

Crepe Twill

A crepe weave (see entry) is a treadling method generally applied to a straight twill. In contrast, a crepe twill, described by Marguerite Porter Davison, has an interesting threading, which can be woven with a number of treadling options. The drawdown and the fabric below use the straight twill treadling. Because the threading can be confusing, the first repeat is shown in a lighter blue.
