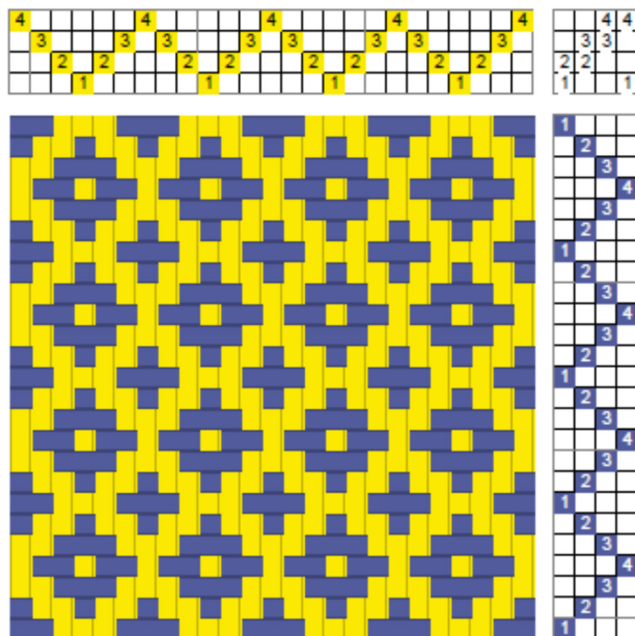
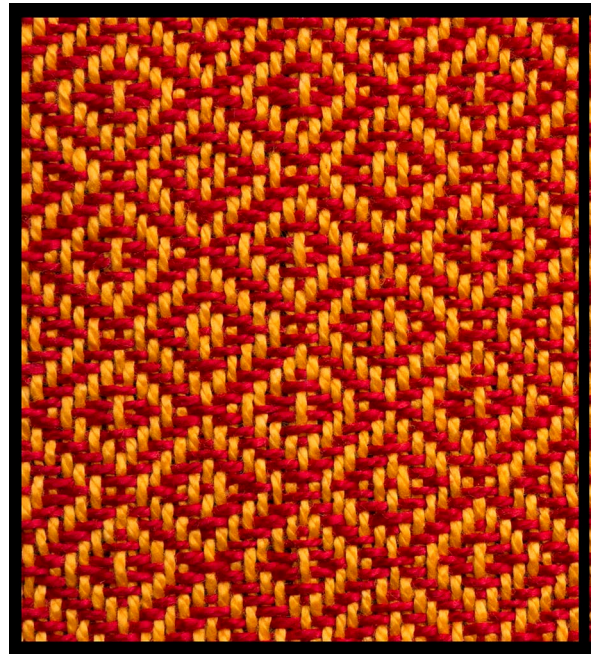
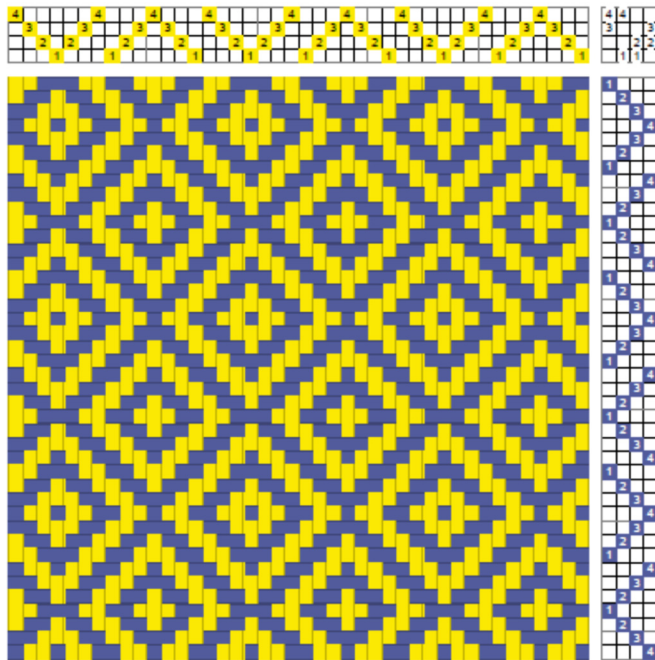


Goose-Eye Twill

The goose-eye twill is in the pointed twill family; we obtain it by combining a pointed twill and a reverse pointed twill. The two sides of the fabric are the same. Below are the drawdown and the fabric sample.



On the left is the drawdown of the pointed twill. The basic outline of the diamond is made more obvious in the goose-eye twill; there are two additional layers of motifs in the goose-eye as compared to pointed. When we want a bolder pattern, the goose-eye twill is a good choice.
