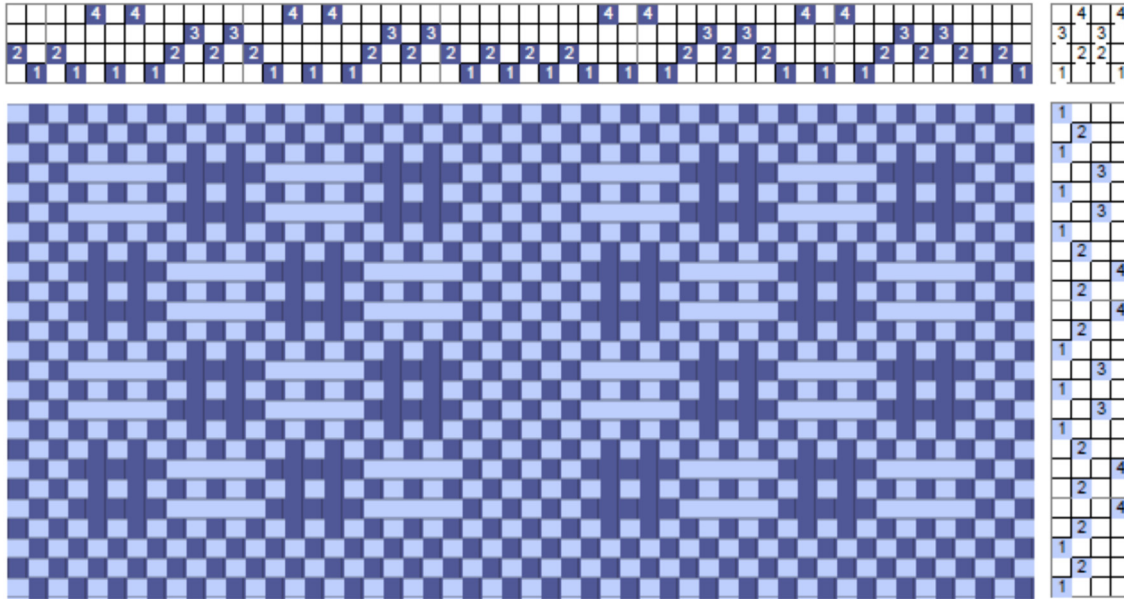


Huck Lace

Huck Lace shares the same threading as huck (see entry), but allows warp and weft floats to be woven together: when one block weaves weft floats, the other weaves warp floats and *vice versa*. As in huck, plain weave can be woven across and down the length of the fabric. It can be used to stabilize the fabric, as can be seen in the blue drawdown and the fabric below with stripes of lace and plain weave.
