

Month 10: Color and Weave


- Color and weave is an effect we obtain when the structure and color interact to form a design where the original structure is no longer apparent
- Usually woven with plain weave and twills, although there are other possibilities


Color and Weave on Plain Weave






Color and Weave on Twills





Shadow Weave

- Some consider shadow weave in a class of its own, arguing that the twill motif, which is its basis, is often obvious (see example on the right)
- However, if we look at the actual intersections, a lot is the "one over, one under" of plain weave
